RE: **Electronics Recycling Expansion**

Dear Members:

The Northeast Kingdom Waste Management District (NEKWMD) has recently added several items to the list of acceptable electronics. Effective immediately, the NEKWMD will be accepting the following items for recycling/reuse:

If your town wishes to collect these items at your transfer station and/or recycling center, the NEKWMD will charge \$0.18/pound to the town and pick them up when we service your center. This is the same rate we are already charging for computers and televisions.

Anyone who brings these items to the Lyndonville facility will be charged a flat rate of \$3.00 per item.

Your town is free to set whatever rate they wish or no rate at all- keeping in mind that you will be billed the \$0.18 fee referenced above.

RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING IN THE NEK*

NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES & OFFICE PAPER (JUNK MAIL): Can be mixed together - Include catalogs, telephone books, glossy inserts and paperback books as well as colored paper, white paper, wrapping paper and junk mail. Any color or type of paper can be in this category except brown Kraft bags and boxboard.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD & BROWN KRAFT BAGS & BOXBOARD: NO wax-coated cardboard, egg cartons, cardboard soiled with food waste or Styrofoam. Remove excess tape. Staples: OK. Please no strings, handles, or bags with plastic layers.

TIN CANS: Labels are OK. Flattening not required. Separate from aluminum cans (A magnet will stick to tin but not to aluminum). Please rinse.

ALUMINUM CANS, FOIL AND FOOD TRAYS: Labels OK. Flattening not required, please rinse. Snack bags and candy wrappers are not aluminum foil!

GLASS (ALL COLORS): Clear, green, blue, and amber bottles and jars. Dishes, window, mirror, ceramic, Pyrex and drinking glasses are acceptable. Please rinse. NO crystal, lids, metal or wood. NO light bulbs.

#1 through #7 PLASTICS: Look for the recycling number stamped on the bottom of the container. Includes all labeled rigid plastic containers and lids. Labels are OK, please crush larger containers. Ty and automotive product containers are acceptable as long as they are completely drained of fluid. Please rinse! No vinyl siding, Styrofoam, syringes or medical devices - call for proper disposal options for them.

PLASTIC BAGS: Any plastic bag that is labeled #2 or #4, or has been identified as such. Call for the current list of acceptable bags.

SPECIAL WASTES:

Oil, Oil Filters, Automotive Batteries, Rechargeable Batteries, Aerosol cans, Agricultural Bale Wrap, Hard and Soft covered Books, Printer Cartridges, Lead fishing sinkers, Propane tanks, Cellular Phones Electronics (TV's & Computers) (fees apply for electronics), and Fluorescent Bulbs are all collected year round in Lyndonville.

Clothing and Textiles - Drop and Swaps are held in the spring and fall in Derby and Lyndonville.

Scrap Metal, White Goods, and Tires - Snow-free months, Mon-Fri 8:00AM - 4:00PM and Saturday 8:00AM to 3:00PM. Fees apply for tires.

Household Hazardous Waste - BY APPOINTMENT ONLY, Monday - Friday, June through the end of September in Lyndonville, and special events throughout the District June - September. Call for details.

SWAP SHOP:

In Lyndonville - Pick-up or drop-off any small, clean household item in good working condition.

Lyndonville walk-in is open to residents of all NEKWMD Towns
